Text: Deuteronomy 6:1-9

1. Protect your family through personal purity.

“He will even deliver one who is not innocent; Yes, he will be delivered by the **purity** of your hands.” Job 22:30

2. Protect your children by affirming they belong to the Lord.

“Behold, children *are* a heritage from the LORD...” Psalm 127:3

3. Protect your children by instilling the fear of God in their hearts

“...by the fear of the Lord men depart from evil” Proverbs 16:6 (KJV)

“The fear of the LORD *is* to hate evil; Pride and arrogance and the evil way And the perverse mouth I hate.” Proverbs 8:13

4. Protect your family by teaching them the truth about temptation

“Choosing rather to suffer affliction with the people of God, than to enjoy the pleasures of sin for a season;” Hebrews 11:25 (KJV)

5. Protect your family by praying for their protection

“Have You not made a hedge around him, around his household, and around all that he has on every side? You have blessed the work of his hands, and his possessions have increased in the land.” Job 1:10
